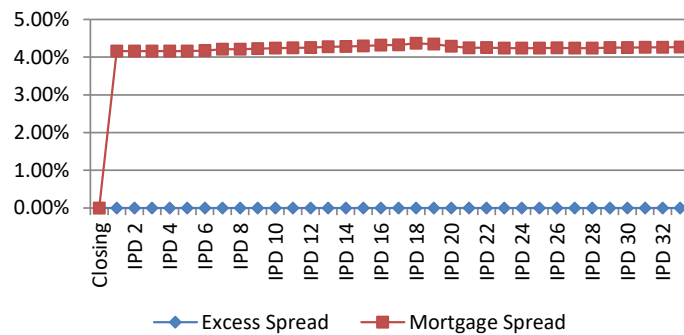
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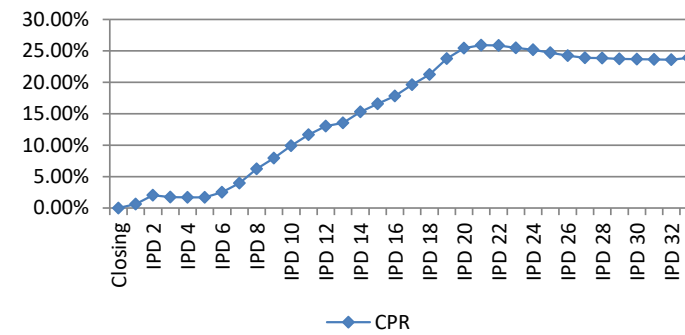

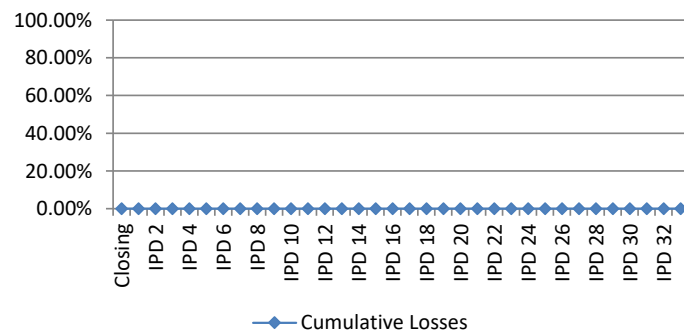
Mortgage Margin & Excess Spread



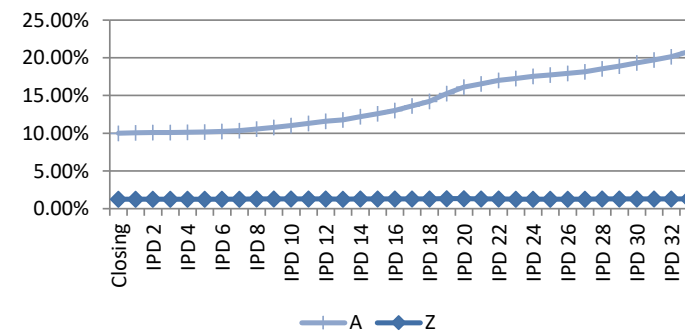
CPR (since issue)

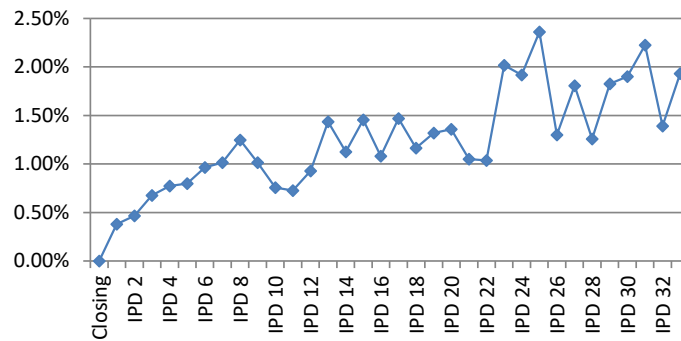


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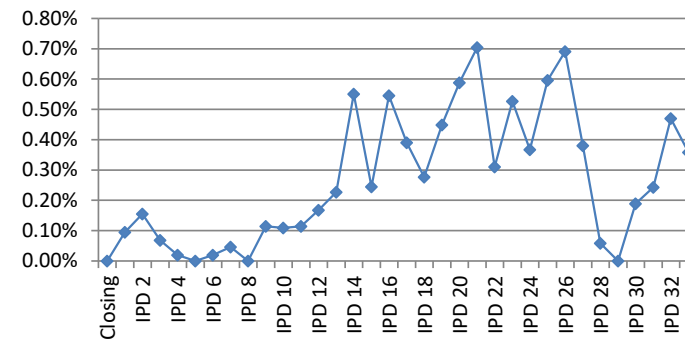

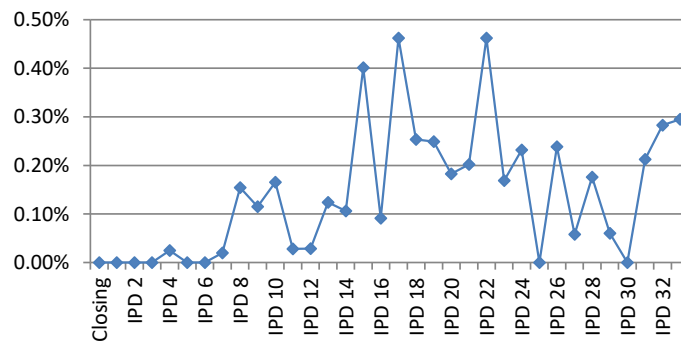
Delinquencies (1-2 Months in Arrears)



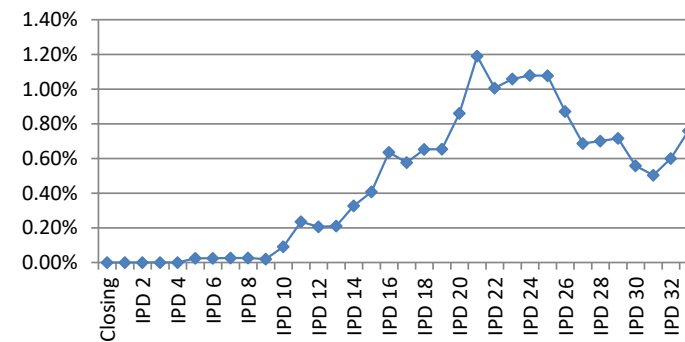
Delinquencies (2-3 Months in Arrears)

On the Closing Date, the Seller has undertaken to the Issuer and the Security Trustee that it will (subject to the provisos set out in the Mortgage Sale Agreement):

(a) retain on an ongoing basis the Retained Interest in accordance with the Retention Requirements;

(b) at all relevant times comply with the requirements of:

(i) Article 7(l)(e)(iii) of the UK Securitisation Regulation by confirming the risk retention of the Seller as contemplated by Article 6(1) of the UK Securitisation Regulation and

(ii) Article 7(l)(e)(iii) of the EU Securitisation Regulation by confirming the risk retention of the Seller as contemplated by Article 6(1) of the EU Securitisation Regulation, but solely as such articles are interpreted and applied on the Closing Date;

(c) not sell, hedge or otherwise mitigate (and shall procure that none of its affiliates shall sell, hedge or otherwise mitigate) the credit risk under or associated with the Retained Interest except to the extent permitted under the UK Securitisation Regulation or as would be permitted as determined in accordance with Article 6 of the EU Securitisation Regulation as required for the purposes of Article 5(1)(d) of the EU Securitisation Regulation; and

(d) not change the manner or form in which it holds the Retained Interest.

As at the Closing Date, the UK Retention Requirement and EU Retention Requirement will each be satisfied by the Seller holding the first loss tranche and other tranches having the same or a more severe risk profile than those transferred or sold to investors, in this case, represented by the retention by the Seller of the Class Z Notes, (a) in accordance with Article 6(3)(d) of the UK Securitisation Regulation and (b) under the Transaction Documents in connection with Article 6(3)(d) of the EU Securitisation Regulation (as required for the purposes of Article 5(1)(d) of the EU Securitisation Regulation) as though Article 6 of the EU Securitisation Regulation applied to the transaction, not taking into account any relevant national measures (as contractual obligations only), but solely as such articles are interpreted and applied on the Closing Date, provided that on and from the applicable SR Equivalency Date (but only for so long as SR Equivalency is maintained), references to, and obligations in respect of, the EU Securitisation Regulation shall not apply. Any change to the manner in which such interest is held will be notified to Noteholders.

Except with the express written consent of the Seller in the form of a U.S. Risk Retention Consent and where such sale falls within the exemption provided by Section 20 of the U.S. Risk Retention Rules, the Notes or the Residual Certificates offered and sold by the Issuer may not be purchased by any person except for persons that are not Risk Retention U.S. Persons.

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Prepayment Rate (CPR)

Average Constant Prepayment Rate (CPR) Since Issue with Calculation

Average CPR speed is the amount expressed as an annualised percentage of principal prepaid in excess of scheduled repayments. The average CPR speed is calculated by first dividing the Current Residential Mortgage Loan Principal Balance (i.e. the actual balance) by the Scheduled Residential Mortgage Loan Principal Balance assuming no prepayments have been made (i.e. only scheduled repayments have been made). The quotient is then raised to a power whereby the exponent is the quantity twelve divided by the number of months since issue. Subtract this result from one then multiply it by one hundred (100) to determine the Average CPR speed.
